This is the installation instructions for the OMC Sea Drive Transom Mount Assembly. The OMC Sea Drive drive unit is packaged separately and can be conveniently installed by the dealer preparing the boat for sale to the new owner. Careful attention to these detailed installation instructions will assure simple accurate installation for a new boat or the repower of an older one. Read these instructions thoroughly before attempting an installation to familiarize yourself with all the steps necessary to perform as well as the other systems necessary to match this unique marine propulsion system.

Use only parts specially designed to be compatible with the OMC Sea Drive. Parts of lesser quality, material and/or strength may cause failure of unit and injury.
